by assoc. prof., PhD, Nikolay Antonov Ivanov, FMI-SU over a contest for academic position "associate professor" in professional field 4.6 Informatics and Computer Sience, scientific field "Informatics" (Computer modeling of complex systems with large dimension), for the needs of the Institute of Mathematics and Informatics - BAS

The contest is announced in volume 14 of the Governmental Newspaper from the 10-th of February, 2023. The only candidate is Ivan Radoslavov Georgiev, currently and assoc. prof. at Rouse University "Angel Kanchev".

Ivan Radoslavov Georgiev is born on the 25-th of October, 1983, in the town of Gorna Oryahovitsa. In 2005, he obtained a Bachelor degree form Ruse University in the field of "Pegagogy of Education in Mathematics and Informatics". In 2007, he obtained a Masters degree form Ruse University in the fields of "Informational and Educational Technologies". In 2015, he obtained a PhD degree form Ruse University in the field of "Mathematical Modeling and Applications of Mathematics". The title of his dissertation is "Embedded-Interface-Finite-Element Method for Elliptic and Parabolic Problems".

Ivan Georgiev worked as a part-time assistant form 2005 to 2009, as a full-time assistant form 2009 to 2016, as a principal assistant form 2016 to 2022, and as an associate professor form 2022 to the present day. All these positions he held in Ruse University.

From the attached certificates on teaching, work experience, and participation of development of university courses, it becomes clear that the candidate has a rich teaching experience.

Assoc. prof., PhD, Ivan Georgiev has submitted a complete set of documents and materials, in accordance with The Law on Academic Development in the Republic of Bulgaria, The Regulations for its application and the Regulations for the terms and conditions for acquiring scientific degrees and for holding academic positions in the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences. In the contest, the candidate participates with 20 publications, from which 16 have SJR and 5 are indexed in the databases, as well as with 3 chapters of books. All the publications of the applicant are with co-authors. I assume that he has contributed equally in his works. Moreover, the candidate has presented 41 citations of his works.

The presented publications and citations satisfy the minimal national criteria (according to Art. 2b, para. 2 and 3 of LDASRB) and the additional requirements of the Bulgarian Accademy

Scientific interests of the candidate are related to optimization of mathematical models that are direct interpretation of processes due to human activity or (in part) are related to the phenomena of Nature. Particularly good impression is made by the practical directionality of the research. The research is related to finance, transportation, ecology, energy efficiency, beekeeping and others.

The results are obtained by algorithms, implemented mainly on Mathlab. For the development of these algorithms is applied knowledge in the following fields of Mathematics: Mathematical Optimization (continuous, as well as discrete), Numerical Methods for Ordinary Differential Equations, Probability Theory, Statistics, and others fields.
