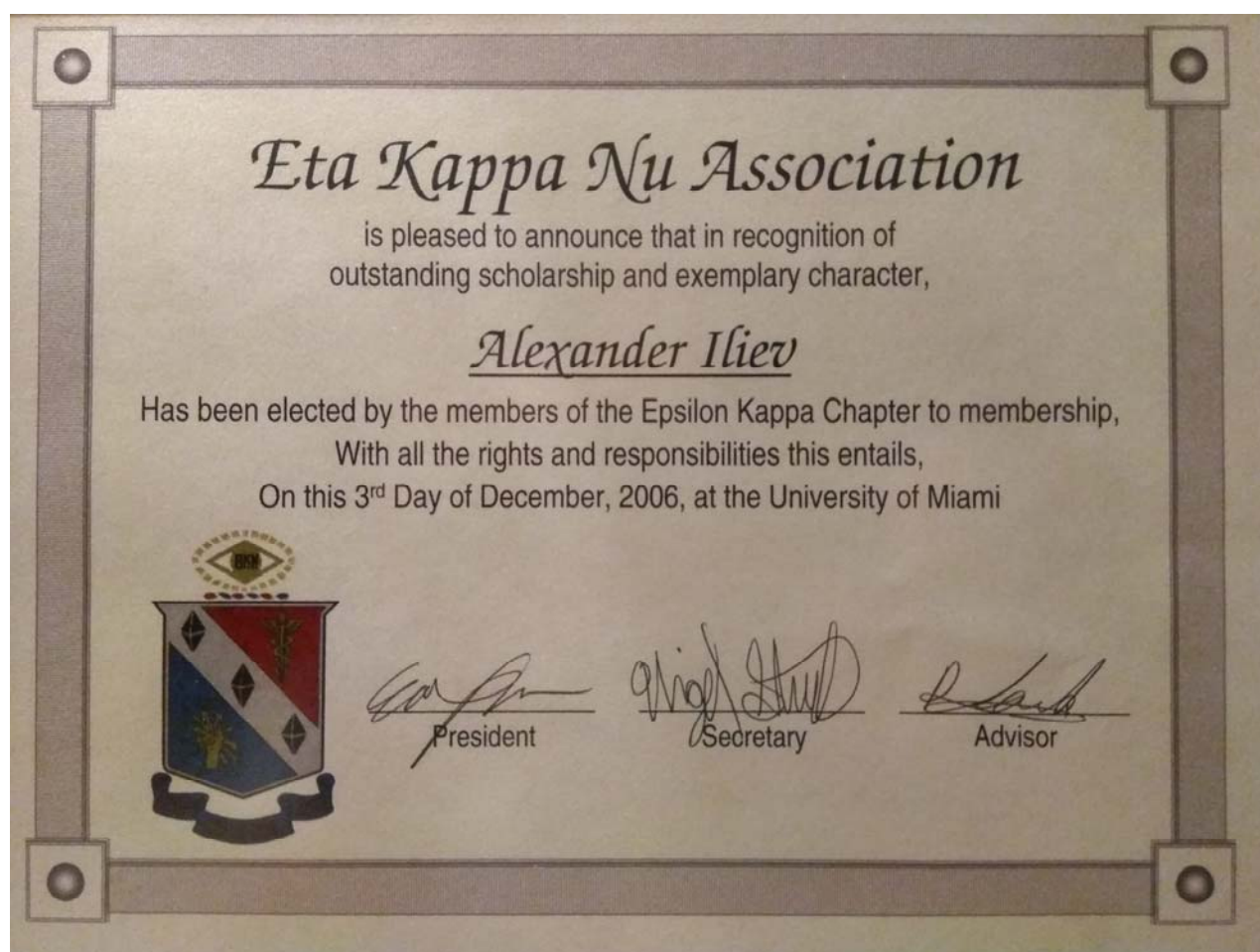

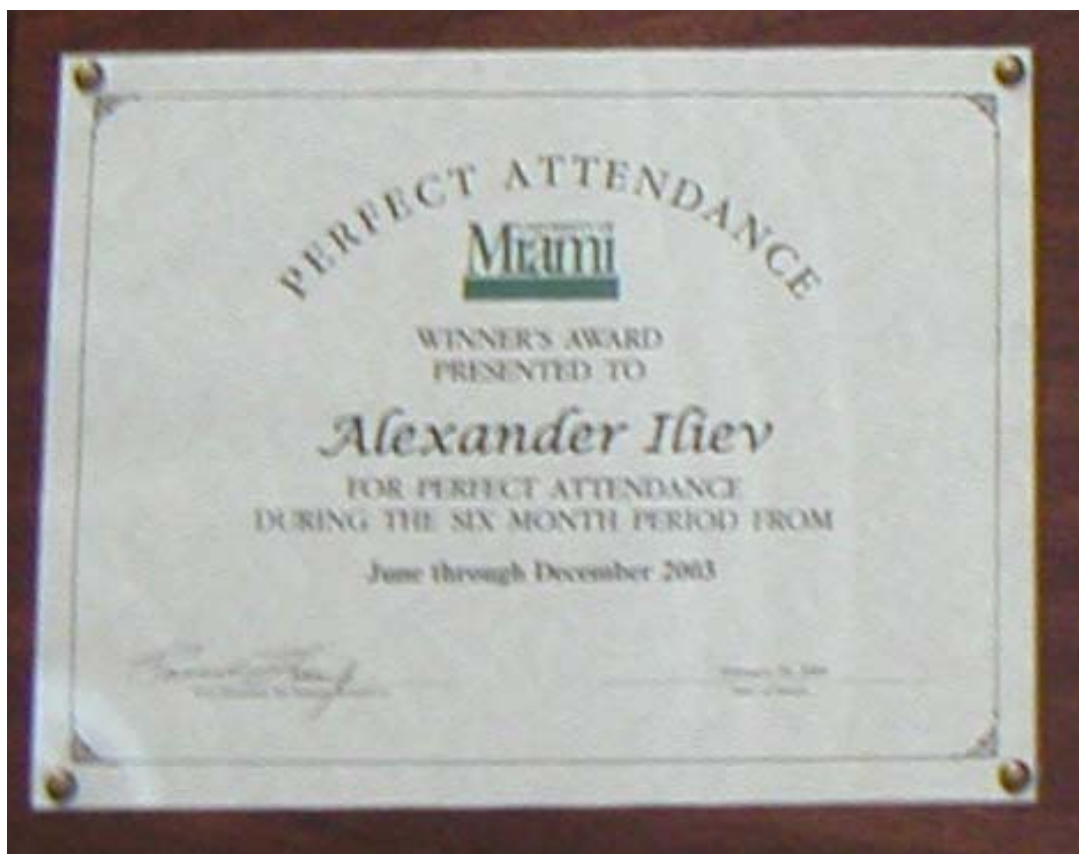
- Honor Society “Eta Kappa Nu”, Nov.2006

### IT GURU IS LATEST WINNER OF PERFECT ATTENDANCE AWARD

Alexander Iliev, a software specialist in Information Technology, is the latest winner of the Perfect Attendance Award, which recognizes full-time staff members who do not use any sick days over a six-month span.

Iliev, who provides support for the College of Engineering's Web site and is also the system administrator for the college's Edward H. Arnold Center for Confluent Media Studies, did not miss a single day of work from June to December 2003. His reward: two roundtrip airline tickets to any destination in the United States.

Iliev plans to visit Alaska, one of the world's best destinations for rock climbing, a hobby he took up two years ago.

A University alumnus with a master's degree in electrical engineering and music engineering technology, Iliev says his Alaskan vacation will be a welcome change of pace from the high-tech world of IT, which he encounters almost on a daily basis.
