19-23 November 2020, Veliko Tarnovo, Bulgaria

The Sixth Scientific Conference with International Participation "Cultural and Historical Heritage: Preservation, Presentation, Digitization" (KIN2020) will be held in Veliko Tarnovo.

Main directions of the conference are preservation, digitization and presentation of the world and national tangible and intangible cultural heritage (CHH). The Interdisciplinary Forum aims to present scientific and applied research, projects, and innovations in the field of cultural and historical heritage (CHH). The main focus of the KIN2020 will be the current research trends and innovative applications in this broad spectrum area, as well as the Bulgarian experience in the presentation and digitalization of scientific and cultural heritage. Extended versions of the CIN research reports presented at the forum will be published after double-blind review. The publication is registered in NACID.

- 7. Art and Modern Technology

The program will include reports from leading experts from Bulgaria and abroad, a roundtable, an exhibition and demonstrations presenting the efforts of scientists, cultural institutions and organizations from various fields to document, archive, present and preserve the CHH. Within the KIN2020 will be organized and presented: Scientific reports and announcements on the announced topics (up to 15 min / report); Presentation of the results of projects for the documentation, preservation and broad public access to cultural heritage in libraries, museums, archives and galleries; Special section on cultural tourism.

The conference is expected to include renowned experts from Bulgaria and abroad with extensive experience in the conservation, presentation and digitization of CIN. Research institutes, universities, libraries, museums, archives, galleries, business representatives and tourist information centers are invited to exchange experience, ideas and results on the topic of the conference.
