

## REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORS

Use the Microsoft Word template [DOCX](#) to prepare your manuscript. If your paper is not prepared in the journal format, it will not be accepted for consideration by the Editorial board.

Submit your paper to the journal using the following email address:

Before you offer a scientific paper for publication, make sure that:

- issues about publication ethics, copyright, authorship, figure formats, data and references format have been appropriately considered;
- all authors have approved the content of the submitted manuscript;
- manuscripts submitted to the journal should neither been published before nor be under consideration for publication in another journal or conference.

Plagiarism in all its forms constitutes unethical publishing behavior and is unacceptable. We are using professional tools from preventing plagiarism.

All papers will be single-blind peer-reviewed by at least two members of the Editorial board. All submissions will be reviewed based on relevance, originality, significance, soundness, and clarity.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SCIENTIFIC PAPER FORMATTING

- the proposed scientific work should be up to 12 pages in size, containing up to 10 figures. Larger scientific papers are also published after approval by the scientific editorial board;
- the paper should contain the description of your research and should be structured in different sections such as: Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusions, Acknowledgements (if applicable) and References. In particular, manuscripts should include an introductory part with representation and analysis of the problem(s) under consideration and current state-of-the-art of the existing solutions; exposition of the investigation and comments on the results obtained; evaluation of the contribution indicating advantages, limitations and possible directions for future research;
- manuscripts should be written in clear and grammatically correct language. The official languages of the Journal “Cultural and Historical Heritage: Preservation, Representation, Digitalization” is English, Bulgarian and Russian. The following elements must be present in English in the publication:

- ✓ paper title;
- ✓ author's name(s), affiliation(s), country(ies), e-mail(s);
- ✓ abstract and keywords in English;
- ✓ references in English (literacy transcribed if needed).

References should follow the APA standard and should be listed at the end of manuscript.

Requirements for the writing of the used scientific literature (References):

- contains only scientific literature and scientific sources. Everything else as explanations, additions or web addresses are mentioned in a footnote;
- references should follow the APA standard and should be listed at the end of manuscript;
- the list of used scientific literature is written in English or transliterated in Latin letters, and other language writing in square brackets is allowed after that. Note: Citation in a language other than English may be used in a footnote, but it is mandatory to list the references in English at the end of the manuscript;
- references are arranged first alphabetically and then sorted chronologically if necessary;
- a scientific source is considered to be a publication in a scientifically referenced publication or book; electronic source with proven scientific value; clearly traceable author's statement;
- references contain the following elements:
  1. author or authors, written in Latin - first surname, then first name or abbreviation of first name (bold);
  2. in the second place is the year of publication in brackets;
  3. in the third place is the title of the cited publication or book, etc.;
  4. in the fourth place it is written where the scientific source is published/reported. More precisely: if it is a report in which conference, if it is a chapter of a book in which book, if it is an article in which magazine, etc. If a whole book is cited, this part can be omitted (or the editors can be written);
  5. in fifth place is written the name of the publisher and the city and country of publication;
  6. lastly, the technical information of the scientific source is written, such as ISSN or ISBN or DOI and general pages of the report or book.
