**of Professor H.M. SRIVASTAVA**

Prof. Dr. **Hari M. Srivastava**, Dept. Mathematics & Statistics, University of Victoria, B.C. - Canada, **born on 5 July 1940** had this summer his happy occasion of **60th Jubilee!**

**On behalf of the Editorial Board of our “FCAA” Journal**, I like to wish him many happy returns to this day and to continue in the same enthusiastic way his tireless serving in favour of the mathematical community and his various scientific activities!

Below I try to reproduce only a part of his academic career's data:

**Main research interests:** Special Functions, Integral Equations and Transforms, Univalent Functions, Fractional Calculus, Applications of Analysis, Analytic Number Theory etc. Author of an extremely huge list of research papers and of a series of books and handbooks in these areas, published by prestigious international publishers. Also editor and co-editor of a series of proceedings, collected papers, and other scientific publications.

He has the following **honorary positions** at prestigious scientific institutions and universities abroad:

- Honorary Foreign Member of the Roayl Academy of Sci., Literature and Fine arts of Belgium (formally elected since 1991 and approved by the Royal Decree of 1993 of His Majesty the King of Belgium);
- Chartered Mathematician (incorporated by Royal Charter - UK) and Confirmed by Order of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council (since 1991);
- Honorary Academician and Correspondent Member of La Academia Canaria de Ciencias, Spain (since 1998);
- Honorary Prof. at Institute of Basic Research in Palm Harbor - FL, USA (since 1992) and at its branch, Istituto per la Ricerca di Base (IRB) in Monteroduni, Italy (since 1995);
- Honorary Advisory Prof. at Fudan Univ. - Shanghai, China (1993);
- Honorary Professor at Universidad del Zulia - Maracaibo, Venezuela (since 1996).

**Prof. Srivastava is a Fellow** of the following associations:

- Royal Astronom. Soc., London - UK (1968); - Nat. Acad. Sci. of India (1969); - Inst. Maths and Its Appl-s, UK (1975); - Vijnana Parishad (Sci. Acad.) of India (1993, as one of the first two honorary fellows); - American Association for the Advancement of Sci., USA (1996); - Forum d'Analystes, India (1999).

**Member of Edit. Boards of more than 50 reputed scientific journals**, among which I like specially to emphasize his membership in the Editorial Boards of the following **international journals, published or edited in Bulgaria**: “Fractional Calculus & Applied Analysis”, “Communications in Applied Analysis”, “Internat. J. Applied Mathematics”, “Internat. J. Differential Equations and Applications”.

**Member of the Organizing and Sci. Committees** of: “Internat. Conf. on Boundary Value Problems, Special Functions and Fractional Calculus” and “AMADE” (Minsk, Belarus), “Internat. Colloquia on Differential Equations” (“ICDE”, Plovdiv, Bulgaria), also - Organizer of Special Sessions on Integral Transforms and Special Functions at these Colloquia, Vice-President of Org. Committee of “ICDE - 11” (Plovdiv, August 2000), etc.

**Reviewer** of Math. Rev., Zbl. für Math, Appl. Mech. Reviews.; external referee, advisor and examiner for several Ph.D. and D.Sc. theses, of committees for international awards; referee and edit. consultant for several Asian, European and American journals and publishers; member of res. board of advisors of “The American Biographical Institute” (USA); referee for Research Grant Projects to Nat. Sci. Foundation - USA and Internat. Sci. Foundation of USA; of NATO and of Natural Sci. and Engineering Res. Council of Canada.
