Tournament of Towns

Area: Mathematics

Style of Competition: Competition between towns. It is carried in two stages – autumn and spring tournament. The students are separated in two groups according to their age. Also, students compete in two levels – \mathbf{O} , or lower level and \mathbf{A} , or upper level. The results of the best participants from certain town are taken into consideration for the overall result.

Target Group: The participants are students from grades 7 to 12 with serious interest in mathematics.

Age of Participants: 14 - 19.

School level of Participants: High schools.

Number of Participants in the Last Years: Each year around 300 students take part in the competition.

History of Competition: The first Tournament of Towns took place in Moscow in year 1980. Now over 100 towns from more than 25 countries take part in it.

Financial Basis of the competition: Each town pays a fee to the central organizing committee.
